The Homer Davis Project is a social action effort of the Jewish Federation of Southern Arizona. The Homer Davis Project reaches out to underserved school children in our community at Homer Davis Elementary School, part of the Flowing Wells Unified School District. At Homer Davis Elementary 85% - 90% of the children meet poverty guidelines for free or reduced-price breakfast and lunch. The JFSA committee at Homer Davis are committed to providing weekend food packs for those students who were identified at risk and who receive little or no nutritious food over the weekend. In addition to providing the weekend food pack program a group of volunteers work with the students after school in a Homework Helpers Program. Homer Davis Elementary is K-6 with approximately 448 students.
