## Class Descriptions

### Acting Academy

Students will develop their acting and improvisational skills through theater activities, improv games, and a play – all online! At the end of the quarter, the virtual performance will be recorded and then shared with the students and their families at a Zoom Viewing Party!!! There are no auditions and all students have speaking parts.

### Actor's Workshop

Students will learn from home and work with our Director live over 8 sessions. Students will learn about the key tools that actors use to portray their characters and how to develop depth and layers to the characters they play. They will also learn about thinking on their feet engaging in improvisational exercises. Students will work on monologues, writing and directing their own monologues, and performing in a scene with other actor(s) as a part of this program! Our Instructor will provide coaching and feedback for all our actors so they can improve their acting skills for future auditions and performances!

### Advanced Chess

Safely have fun playing chess games against friends remotely! Students continue to build strategy and play chess games online through an amazing program, ChessKid. A coach will assist students in matches against fellow friends and teach them different chess techniques. Some prior experience necessary.

### Beginning Chess

Safely have fun playing online chess games against friends! Students build strategy and play chess games online through an amazing program, ChessKid. A coach will assist students in matches against fellow friends and teach them different chess techniques. Open to all ability levels, no prior experience necessary.

### Beat Drop Kidz

This Program is a Hip Hop Dance Program that brings the fun of Hip Hop Dance directly into the schools! We teach Hip Hop in a Kid-Friendly & FUN way while teaching the “Code of Hip Hop” of “Peace, Unity, Love & Having Fun”. Students will learn several moves from various Urban Dance styles such as Popping, Break Dancing, Locking & more!

### Capoeira

Capoeira is a Brazilian martial art/dance form that improves physical and mental strength and encourages creativity while increasing agility and confidence. Instructor Anne Pollack has trained in Capoeira for over 22 years. This class will be held outside.

### Cheer

Become a member of the first-ever Sunset Spirit Squad! Sunset Cheer will teach students the fundamentals of performing cheer, dances, jumps, and basic motions. Their experienced staff will also lead students through strengthening and agility exercises all while emphasizing teamwork and school spirit. This is a non-competitive squad that will kids together remotely.

### Color Me Mine

Every week the kids will experience working with wood, ceramic and clay using both acrylic and water-based paints.

### Creative Drama

Students will develop public speaking and leadership skills, while building confidence, and learning how to think quickly, creatively, and appropriately. All of this is done through our fun and energetic theater based curriculum. Students will participate in various activities including scene building, creative movement, short plays, and theater games. There are never any auditions and ALL students have the chance to shine!

### Creative Writing

Students will have the opportunity to share their writing and get feedback from peers and their teacher. All styles of writing are encouraged--poetry, fiction, creative non-fiction, essay writing, and journalism will be covered and a school newsletter will be produced by the students.

## **Improv**

Improv is an unscripted form of theater where the participants come up with everything on the spot. Scenes go from funny to funnier, all spurred by the creativity of the performers. Join us as we go over the basic principles of improv, and learn how to think quickly and creatively for any situation! Students will participate in classic improv games played by professionals around the world.

## **Intro to Coding**

Students will be taught a strategy and then have to produce something that shows understanding. Dr. Mary S. Florek is a Gifted Specialist in the Catalina Foothills School District. She has her master's in reading and her doctorate in curriculum and instruction. She is currently teaching grades 3-4-5 at Sunrise Drive and Canyon View Elementary. She loves both children and reading!
