# Descriptions

## 3D Perler Beads

3D Disney characters, a pokeball, a jewelry box, and a toucan are just some of the MANY things that can be made out of perler beads! In this class children will choose the 3D design of their choice to work on weekly utilizing patterns, their patients and creativity to create something extraordinary! The 3D perler bead patterns work like a 3D puzzle with each side of the structure designed to fit within each other. What will you make? The possibilities are endless! This is a process project class and most 3D projects will take multiple classes to complete.

## Beginning Scrapbooking

This fun and hands on class will stimulate the children's creativity using the scrapbook techniques and memory keeping. They will also increase their skills in motion coordination, space notion and more. It is a good way to enjoy photos off- screen.

## Build IT, Make IT, Take IT: STEM

Campers will explore the world of STEM using a variety of hands on activities. We will take everyday materials to make everything from Oobleck to balloon powdered vehicles.
