**ONLINE ONLY REGISTRATION** - We are accepting registrations online only. Please make sure to log into our system and create an account before registration day! If you do not remember your login please call us, do not create a new account! No paper copies will be accepted. Registration cannot be taken over the phone. Classes are filled on a first-come, first-served basis, often fill quickly and are subject to cancellation due to low enrollment.

### **Attendance:**

Attendance is taken for all Extended Day Activities & absences must be phoned in by parents to the school office by 2:00 p.m. the day of the class.

### **Cell Phones and Other Communication Devices:**

Community Schools adheres to the same cell phone/communication device policy in effect during school hours. Students must follow and abide by the technology user agreement and discipline code. For a detailed description of the exact policy, please refer to your student planner.

### **Refunds/Changes:**

Class cancelled by Community Schools (**No fees charged, 100% refund**). Refund or cancellation requested before the start of class (**\$10 change fee for any class changes or cancellations before the quarter begins**).

**No refunds** will be given after the 2nd day of class.

**No refunds** if we remove your student from a class.

### **Cash or Checks:**

If you can only pay by cash or checks please contact our main office at 209-7551. There will be a \$25 processing fee for checks returned for insufficient funds.

### **Wait List:**

Online registration is processed in real time and is the most efficient way to register. Once a class has reached maximum enrollment, parents may request that their student be placed on a waiting list. All waiting list requests are dated, time-stamped, and entered accordingly. Exact positions on the waitlist cannot be guaranteed. The fastest way to place your student on the waitlist is to call the Community Schools office directly at 209-7551. Any waitlist request left with the CS coordinators or school front office staff, will be entered as time permits.
