Class Descriptions and Grades

Acting Academy 6-8

Develop your acting skills as you collaborate with other students on a short play. Each class begins with fun theater games to build skills that will benefit you both on and off stage. After that, rehearsals take place in preparation for a performance at the end of the quarter. (Depending on the circumstances this might be shared virtually instead of our usual in person showcase.) There are no auditions and all students have speaking parts in the play!

Afro-Brazilian Dance 1-5

Traditional Afro-Brazilian dances will be the heart of this class. Students will learn basic steps of Samba de Roda, a traditional form of samba. They will also learn Maculelê, a stick-fighting dance that has roots in the stories of escape from slavery (modified to play safely), and Puxada de Rede, a dance whose moves and music come from and honor the fishing culture of Brazil. Teacher Anne Pollack (Capoeira Mandinga Tucson) is the only master of Capoeira and Afro-Brazilian arts in the State of Arizona.

Advanced Chess 4-8

Safely have fun playing chess games against friends remotely! Students continue to build strategy and play chess games online through an amazing program, ChessKid. A coach will assist students in matches against fellow friends and teach them different chess techniques. Some prior experience necessary.

Basketball Skills w/ Mr. Remy 3-5

Learn how to dribble, pass and shoot and Mr. Remy! You will learn the basic rules of basketball and how to work together as a team all while practicing sportsmanship.

Beginning Chess K-5

Safely have fun playing online chess games against friends! Students build strategy and play chess games online through an amazing program, ChessKid. A coach will assist students in matches against fellow friends and teach them different chess techniques. Open to all ability levels, no prior experience necessary.

Beat Drop Kidz K-5

This Program is a Hip Hop Dance Program that brings the fun of Hip Hop Dance directly into the schools! We teach Hip Hop in a Kid-Friendly & FUN way while teaching the “Code of Hip Hop” of “Peace, Unity, Love & Having Fun”. Students will learn several moves from various Urban Dance styles such as Popping, Break Dancing, Locking & more!

Building Wealth-Your Future-Your Choices 5-8

You will learn the importance of saving and budgeting and the difference between a debit card and a credit card. You will gain the understanding of the importance of your choices for college and career and how debt can dramatically impact your financial future. We will also learn the difference between a checking account, savings account and an investment account and how they all play a role in your future financial success and wealth building. We will cover how to avoid identity theft and much much more.

Capoeira 1-5

Learn the flowing, beautiful Afro-Brazilian martial art Capoeira with Capoeira Mandinga Tucson. Students will learn kicks, escapes, and fluid moves that build mind and body strength, flexibility, and agility. Students also learn music that drives the energy of the Capoeira game. Capoeira increases balance, creativity, and confidence. Teachers Anne Pollack and Aidan Miller-Wells were honored with a 2019 Southwest Folklife Alliance Award. Aidan has trained capoeira over 12 years. Anne is the only master of Capoeira and Afro-Brazilian arts in the State of Arizona.

Cheer 6-8

Become a member of the first-ever Sunset Spirit Squad! Sunset Cheer will teach students the fundamentals of performing cheer, dances, jumps, and basic motions. Their experienced staff will also lead students through strengthening and agility exercises all while emphasizing teamwork and school spirit.

Color Me Mine K-5

Every week the kids will experience working with wood, ceramic and clay using both acrylic and water-based paints.

Crazy Critters K-5

Meet and learn about different animals each week including goats, pigs, chickens, ducks, capybaras, porcupines, patagonian maras, reptiles and more! We will do a craft and/or fun worksheets related to those animals and then have hands on time with them. **No classes weeks of 1/18, 2/15, 2/22, 3/8**

Creative Kind 2-5

Every week the students will participate in creating a variety of art work and crafts including; Mini Macrame Wall Hangings, Cacti Embroidery Hoops, Mini Fiber Art Rainbows and more in this six- week workshop, 1/12-2/17.

Creative Drama K-5

Students will develop public speaking and leadership skills, while building confidence, and learning how to think quickly, creatively, and appropriately. All of this is done through our fun and energetic theater based curriculum. Students will participate in various activities including scene building, creative movement, short plays, and theater games. There are never any auditions and ALL students have the chance to shine!

Creative Kids, an Odyssey of the Mind Workshop 3-4

Are you a Creative Kid? Do you enjoy making things, being original, trying new ideas EVEN if they don't go as planned? Then you must like...thinking out of the box! Join Ms. Alexander and Mrs. Meder for one of our two "VV Creative Kids" sessions. We will use verbal skills, building ideas, and games to take the ordinary and make it extraordinary. Please sign up for only 1 session - Session 1: 1/20 (Wed) and Mondays- 1/25,2/1, 2/8, 2/15 OR Session 2: Wed, 2/17, Mondays -2/22, 3/1, 3/8, 3/15.

Creative Writing 6-8

Students will have the opportunity to share their writing and get feedback from peers and their teacher. All styles of writing are encouraged--poetry, fiction, creative non-fiction, essay writing, and journalism will be covered and a school newsletter will be produced by the students.

Dramatic Exploration K-5

Dramatic Exploration: Students will harness the power of their imaginations as they explore many facets of drama, including improv, scene building, storytelling, and creative movement. They will develop valuable skills like collaboration, public speaking, self-confidence, and the ability to think quickly and creatively; that will help them both on and off the stage.

E-Sports for Beginners 6-8

Join us at E-Sports Beginners we will learn about, analyze, and execute strategies used by professionals, as we hone our skills using specially developed software to help develop reaction time, memory, and control; as well as playing the video games that make us smile while enjoying the company of our friends. **This class is for beginners and will help to teach you how to play some of these games in a safe and fun environment.**

E-Sports Advanced 6-8

Want to learn insider secrets for League of Legend and Dota2? Join us at E-Sports Advanced, analyze and execute strategies used by professionals, as we hone our skills using specially developed software to help develop reaction time, memory, and control; as well as playing the video games that make us smile while enjoying the company of our friends. **This class is for students who have knowledge on how these games work.** We will be working more on understanding how these games were designed and how to use the strategies to improve the skills we already have.

Exploring Artificial Intelligence 6-8

AI is a part of our lives today and is increasingly becoming more pervasive. This course unravels the mystery behind AI. Students engage in hands-on learning, training models for speech recognition, machine learning and computer vision and develop interactive programs using these models. **Prerequisites:** Prior experience with Scratch programming is required to participate in this course. A laptop or Chromebook with internet connectivity is required to participate in this course.

Hiking Club 6-8

Join Mr. Hook and discover the scenic Sabino Canyon and all that it has to offer. You will need to be able to hike challenging trails. Please wear proper hiking shoes and attire and have a water bottle. Class will take place on Tuesdays and Thursdays. If we should have inclement weather students will attend study hall.

Intro to Javascript 6-8

This course introduces students to the fundamentals of browser-based application development via a fun, graphics and animation and game-based engaging curriculum. Students learn the fundamental programming concepts including variables, conditionals, loops, functions, user inputs, events and lists, and develop a range of applications and a course-end project to showcase their learnings. The programming concepts learned in this course are transferable to any other programming language. No prior coding experience is required to participate in this course. A laptop or Chromebook with internet connectivity is required to participate in this course.

KidStage presents: *The Lion King* 1-5 in-person, 2-6 online class, No classes week of 2/22

When the King of the Pride Lands goes missing, his son must find himself and learn how to protect his land and his people. Follow Simba, Nala, Timon, Pumba, and a colorful cast of animals as they confront the evil Scar and his mangy pack of hyenas in a battle to get their kingdom back. The participants will have a blast in this coming-of-age tale about what it means to believe in yourself, work together and trust in your friends.

KidStage is a theatre and acting class for kids! The curriculum includes concentration, teamwork, improvisation, movement, voice and basic theatre terminology. At the end of the class, KidStage kids will perform for peers and parents. All classes are taught by trained instructors, whose goal it is to teach your child about the excitement of theatre, improve your child's self-confidence, and to provide a safe, fun and interesting environment. KidStage will strengthen your child's confidence as well as build teamwork, leadership, reading, and vocabulary!

KidzArt K-5

A KidzArt certified instructor that will guide students through a different project each week. Students will learn how to break projects into simple steps, art terms and vocabulary, as well as experience and learn techniques for varying drawing mediums. Each week students will bring home a different masterpiece all their own. Our curriculum never repeats!

Let's Get Fit! w/ Ms. Megan 3-5

You will learn a fun way to get healthy and in shape with music and exercise. This course will promote coordination, strength and learning good eating habits. So let's get fit in 2021!

Magic of Reading 2-4

Reading is the gateway skill to all learning and it is important that children love to read. The "magic" in this program gives the children the opportunity to learn strategies in reading like decoding, comprehension, literary elements, fluency, key details, author's purpose and much more. Students will be taught a strategy and then have to produce something that shows understanding. Dr. Mary S. Florek is a Gifted Specialist in the Catalina Foothills School District. She has her master's in reading and her doctorate in curriculum and instruction. She is currently teaching grades 3-4-5 at Sunrise Drive and Canyon View Elementary. She loves both children and reading!

Play-Well Animal Architects K-2

Let your imagination run wild with tens of thousands of LEGO® parts as we design and build leaping dolphins, buzzing beehives, and towering giraffes. Play, create, and learn in a world inspired by the animal kingdom. Design and build as never before and explore your craziest ideas.

Play-Well Animal Architects 3-5

Come enjoy the trails and have fun in our non-competitive Running Club, where we forget the timing clock! The focus will be on endurance and trail running techniques. We will explore nearby Sabino Canyon on our daily runs of 3-4 miles. **Running experience required, students have to be able to run two miles without a break.** Sportsmanship and participation will be emphasized. Proper running shoes and a water bottle are required. A neck gator or Buff are highly recommended but not provided. Must sign a release waiver when signing up.

Scratch Programming 2-5

This course introduces students to block-based programming and provides a fun way for young students to start thinking like a programmer as they explore and develop imaginative stories, animations and games using the Scratch programming environment. Students learn the concepts of motion, looks, sound, events, loops, conditionals, game mechanics, operators and variables as they develop computational thinking and understanding of sequencing, pattern recognition, abstraction and parallelism. No prior coding experience is required to participate in this course. A laptop or Chromebook with internet connectivity is required to participate in this course.

Skyhawks - Mini Hawks 3-5

This multi-sport program was developed to give children a positive first step into athletics. The essentials of the sport are taught in a safe, structured environment with lots of encouragement and a big focus on fun. Our Mini-Hawk games and activities were designed to allow campers to explore balance, movement, hand/eye coordination, and skill development at their own pace. Skyhawks staff are trained to handle the specific needs of young athletes. **Sports vary per school. CV-Basketball, Track & Field, Baseball VV-Track & Field, Baseball, Volleyball SD-Soccer, Track & Field, Baseball**

Skyhawks - STEM Sports 3-5

STEM Sports use sports as the real-life application to engage elementary and middle school-aged participants. Our double-play combination of physical activity and cognitive thinking provides a comprehensive, inquiry-based educational experience and a solution for crucial science, technology, engineering and math (STEM) literacy for students. As a result, students develop: critical thinking, collaboration, creative problem-solving and leadership skills that can be applied throughout their education and future careers.
