Class Descriptions and Grades

3D Perler Beads

3D Disney characters, a pokeball, a jewelry box, and a toucan are just some of the MANY things that can be made out of perler beads! In this class children will choose the 3D design of their choice to work on weekly utilizing patterns, their patients and creativity to create something extraordinary! The 3D perler bead patterns work like a 3D puzzle with each side of the structure designed to fit within each other. What will you make? The possibilities are endless! *This is a process project class and most 3D projects will take multiple classes to complete.*

Acting Academy 6-8

Develop your acting skills as you collaborate with others student on a short play. Each class begins with fun theater games to build skills that will benefit you both on and off stage. After that, rehearsals take place in preparation for a performance at the end of the quarter. (Depending on the circumstances this might be shared virtually instead of our usual in person showcase.) There are no auditions and all students have speaking parts in the play!

Advanced Chess 4-8

Safely have fun playing chess games against friends remotely! Students continue to build strategy and play chess games online through an amazing program, ChessKid. A coach will assist students in matches against fellow friends and teach them different chess techniques. Some prior experience necessary.

Art Naturally 1-5

Each week we will discover an animal and its environment and how it relates to us. We will build on that knowledge and incorporate a themed art lesson using a variety of different mediums, including; watercolors, printmaking, clay, mixed media and more. Price includes all supplies.

Basketball Skills w/ Mr. Remy 2-5

Learn how to dribble, pass and shoot and Mr. Remy! You will learn the basic rules of basketball and how to work together as a team all while practicing sportsmanship.

Beginning Chess K-5

Safely have fun playing online chess games against friends! Students build strategy and play chess games online through an amazing program, ChessKid. A coach will assist students in matches against fellow friends and teach them different chess techniques. Open to all ability levels, no prior experience necessary.

Beat Drop Kidz K-5

This Program is a Hip Hop Dance Program that brings the fun of Hip Hop Dance directly into the schools! Blob Tag Game Development using Javascript 6-8

In this hands-on class, students will learn the fundamentals of Javascript programming and browser-based 2D games and Javascript graphics. The course engages students in creative problem solving and further develops computational thinking, and lays a strong foundation of programming fundamentals including variables, random, conditionals, loops, events and more. By the end of the course, students will use everything they have learned to create the blob tag game. No prior coding experience is required to participate in this course. A computer or Chromebook with internet connectivity is required to join the course.

Building Wealth-Your Future-Your Choices 5-8

Students will learn the importance of saving and budgeting and the difference between a debit card and a credit card. They will understand the importance of their choices for college and career and how debt can dramatically impact their financial future. The students will be taught the difference between a checking account, savings account and an investment account and how they all play a role in their future financial success and wealth building. We will cover how to avoid identity theft and much much more.

Capoeira 1-5

Learn the flowing, beautiful Afro-Brazilian martial art Capoeira with Capoeira Mandinga Tucson. You will learn kicks, escapes, and fluid moves that build mind and body strength, flexibility, and agility. Also learn music that drives the energy of the Capoeira game. Capoeira increases balance, creativity, and confidence. Teachers Anne Pollack and Aidan Miller-Wells were honored with a 2019 Southwest Folklife Alliance Award. Aidan has trained capoeira over 12 years. Anne is the only master of Capoeira and Afro-Brazilian arts in the State of Arizona.

Cheer 6-8

Become a member of the first-ever Sunset Spirit Squad! Sunset Cheer will teach students the fundamentals of performing cheer, dances, jumps, and basic motions. Their experienced staff will also lead students through strengthening and agility exercises all while emphasizing teamwork and school spirit. This is a non-competitive squad that will kids together remotely.

Color Me Mine K-5

Every week the students will experience working with wood, ceramic and clay using both acrylic and water-based paints building on what they have learned the previous week to continue to improve their artistic skills.

Crazy Critters K-5

Java Programming 9-12

This hands-on course introduces students to the fundamentals of Java programming via a mix of fun real-world and graphics, animation, and game-based engaging curriculum. Students learn programming concepts of variables, user inputs/output, conditionals, loops, functions, events and single dimensional array, and put them into practice via imaginative personalized activities. The programming concepts and logic learned in course are directly transferable to any other programming language. No prior coding experience is required to participate in this course. A laptop or Chromebook with internet connectivity is required to participate in this course.

KidStage presents: *The Lion King* 2-5

When the King of the Pride Lands goes missing, his son must find himself and learn how to protect his land and his people. Follow Simba, Nala, Timon, Pumba, and a colorful cast of animals as they confront the evil Scar and his mangy pack of hyenas in a battle to get their kingdom back. KidStage is a theatre and acting class for kids! The curriculum includes concentration, teamwork, improvisation, movement, voice and basic theatre terminology. Students will learn the fundamentals of programming and mobile app development using MIT App Inventor's visual drag and drop coding interface. Students will design, develop, package and share a series of multimedia mobile apps and interactive games. Students are encouraged to follow the link on this page and install the App Inventor Companion App on their device ahead of the first class.

Running Club with Coach Anne Neuenschwander (EC) 6-8

Come enjoy the trails and have fun in our non-competitive Running Club, where we forget the timing clock! The focus will be on endurance and trail running techniques. We will explore nearby Sabino Canyon on our daily runs of 3-4 miles. Running experience required, **students have to be able to run two miles without a break**. Running Club with Ms. Farley (OG) 6-8

Students will learn proper running form through form running drills, learn how to warm up and cool down for a track workout, choose between participating in sprint or middle and long distance workouts, and work on basic core and leg strengthening exercises. Sprinters will also receive instruction on block starts. Students will get to participate in an intrasquad meet at the end of camp to showcase the skills and fitness they gained during camp!

Running Club with Mr. Tompkins (OG) 6-8

An active, healthy club for students who like to run, jog, or walk. We will focus on building endurance and improve physical fitness.

Scratch Junior Programming K-2

This course introduces students to block-based visual programming. In this program students will learn the fundamentals of programming, sequence and pattern recognition while designing and personalizing stories and animations to bring their creativity and imagination to life. No prior coding experience is required to participate in this class. A tablet is required to access the Scratch Junior app.

Scrapbooking

This fun and hands on class will stimulate the children's creativity using the scrapbook techniques and memory keeping. They will also increase their skills in motion coordination, space notion and more. It is a good way to enjoy photos off- screen.

Skyhawks - Mini Hawks 3-5

This multi-sport program was developed to give children a positive first step into athletics. Students will learn the fundamentals of programming by combining coding with art and design for unlimited fun with creating multimedia stories, animations and games using MIT's visual drag and drop Scratch programming interface. Students will get creative with designing their own characters, backdrops, recording sound, adding special effects and learn computational concepts of sequencing, loops, events, modularity and more. No prior coding experience is required to participate in this course. A computer or Chromebook with internet connectivity is required to join the course.

Vocal Lessons 6-8

Learn techniques for singing modern, popular styles of music. Discover how to sing with more power by learning to let go and work less! Gain a better understanding of your voice type, how it works and your range and how to extend that range. You will focus on exercises and apply them to short excerpts. All to choose your own song, work on it with what you learn and present your song at the end!

Volley Ball Skills with Coach Jason Catano 6-8
