1. Are students required to wear masks?

- Because physical distancing cannot always be possible when kids are collaborating, MASKS during our program will be required.
- Masks will NOT be required during physical play or outdoor activities when physical distancing is possible.
- Community Schools will not be providing masks for students.
- All staff members will be wearing masks while on campus.

2. How are students going to be divided and physically distanced?

- Enrollment capacities are set based on the size of room the class will be held in, to ensure that adequate space for physical distancing is available.
- Distancing rules will be explained to the students at the beginning of each class, with gentle reminders when necessary.

3. How will the classrooms and shared spaces be kept clean?

- A professional cleaning staff will clean and sanitize the spaces each night.
- Staff members will clean shared spaces throughout the class as needed.
- Cleaning and disinfecting supplies will be made available to each instructor for use on shared supplies.
- Handwashing will be encouraged throughout your child's time in class.

4. What should we do if our child becomes ill?
