#### **WAITLIST POLICY**

If a class you are wanting to register for fills up, please make sure you click on the yellow button on the class, to be added to the wait list. This will ensure you are contacted if a spot becomes available.

#### **WALKING HOME**

If you would like your student to walk home from our extended day activities, please complete the permission slip at end of this brochure. Turn it in to your Community Schools After School Coordinator or to the district CS office. We will keep this permission slip on file for the school year. If we do not have a signed permission slip, we will not allow students to walk home after our activities.

#### **CLASS CANCELLATION**

Classes are subject to cancellation due to low enrollment. If this happens, you will be contacted by either phone or email prior to the start of the class and awarded a full refund or the option to switch to another class.

#### **ATTENDANCE**

Attendance is taken for all extended day activities, and absences must be emailed by the parents to the After School Coordinator by 2:00pm the day of the class. If students are not in their classes by 3:30pm, an email will go home to parents.

#### LATE PICK-UP FEE

A \$3 per minute fee will be charged for those students who remain on campus after 4:30pm. Please be on time for pick-up.

#### REFUND POLICY

When dropping out of an activity after the first class, you will receive a refund of 50%. NO REFUNDS will be given after the second day of class. There will be a \$10 change fee for any class changes after the start of the class. NO REFUNDS will be given if we remove your student from class. You will receive a FULL REFUND if we have to cancel a class due to low enrollment.

You'll find our registration program at <u>cs.cfsd16.org</u>. If you haven't already, you need to create an account or start a new registration for this school year so that you're ready for Q1 enrollment.

If you are interested in registering for **athletics** this year, you need to complete an athletic packet. This is done through our website at <u>registermyathlete.com</u>. Your athlete will need to be cleared by a doctor every year and you'll download the form for this sports physical that's required when you're completing the process here. NOTE: Just like our registration program, if you already have an account, you just need to log in and complete a new registration for this school year.

My biggest tip... watch for the quarterly registration dates on each quarter's brochure and prepare to log in to your account promptly at 8:30am on those dates. These classes (especially athletics) fill up super fast!! You'll want to be sure to secure your spot early.

- Athletics We offer a wide variety of sports activities for our students, both Intramural (6th grade) and Interscholastic (7th & 8th grades) An athletic packet will need to be uploaded to the RegisterMyAthlete program as described below.

#### **HOW TO GET ENROLLED:**

We email the brochures out to you prior to each quarter of the school year. Please make sure your information in our system and the parentvue system is accurate. If you don't receive a copy via email, we always post our brochure online at <a href="https://communityschools.cfsd16.org/home/school-programs/middle-school-programs">https://communityschools.cfsd16.org/home/school-programs/middle-school-programs</a>
Check the website a few days before enrollment begins!

#### **SOME TIPS:**

Our classes and athletic programs fill up <u>very</u> quickly - sometimes within a few minutes! We encourage you to, if you haven't already, set up a Community Schools account ahead of time to make registration quick and easy at cs.cfsd16.org **NOTE:** If you already have an account, you will simply log in, and update your account by clicking on the NEW 2024/2025 Registration button and make sure your info is current or updated.



- All students who signed up for Athletics are required to have a current sports physical and a completed athletic packet in order to participate. This must be turned in before they can attend a practice or participate in any games. Go to the AKTIVATE program, <a href="https://www.registermyathlete.com">www.registermyathlete.com</a>, and create an account. Here, you will download, sign and upload the forms to us for safe keeping. We will keep it on file for the entire school year, so you only have to do this once per school year.
- Class enrollment is ONLY available ONLINE. If a class or sport is full, you can be added to the waitlist. You will be contacted if a spot becomes available to you.
- Study Hall is available for you to enroll in on a PER DAY basis. You will select which days you
  need on the calendar for as far out as you would like to schedule. You MUST enroll by noon
  the day-of for Study Hall in order to avoid drop-in fees. If your child shows up to study hall,
  and is not enrolled (on the roster), he/she will be considered a "drop in" which will incur a \$15
  fee per occasion.

#### **BUS TRANSPORTATION:**

We DO provide bus transportation home after Community Schools activities for students who already have a bus pass. This <u>does not</u> include half days. Bus transportation will also be provided to and from most normal sporting events. Some exceptions apply. Please refer to the sport schedule for specifics.

#### MIDDLE SCHOOL ATHLETICS

#### 2024-2025 ATHLETICS - ATHLETIC PACKET INFORMATION

Athletic packet submissions, including physical examination documents are began being turned in through "Register My Athlete." (Now called

"AKTIVATE"). This is the same program that you used last year, if your child was in middle school, and the same one you will use at Catalina Foothills High School when you sign up for sports in future years.

**AKTIVATE** is an easy-to-navigate website that streamlines the process of submitting athletic paperwork. Parents create one account for all of their student athletes and can read, e-sign, print, and upload all necessary paperwork. ALL athletes will be required to submit all forms through **AKTIVATE** before the first day of practice for their sport. **You can (and should) do this now and will be cleared in our registration system, even if you aren't playing a sport until the 4th quarter!** This will alleviate delays in starting your athlete's sport!

To access **AKTIVATE** and get started setting up an account (if you are brand new to this site), go to this link: <a href="https://www.registermyathlete.com">www.registermyathlete.com</a> and fill out all the information, then add your athletes.

If you have any difficulties setting up your account, or trouble navigating the website, please contact **AKTIVATE**'s customer support at **support@registermyathlete.com**. They are very responsive during regular business hours and will get back to you as soon as possible.

If you have general questions about athletics at the middle schools, please contact jnoyce@cfsd16.org or call 520-209-7562.

NOTE: If you already use **AKTIVATE** at another school for another athlete, you can just log in and add a new athlete. Likewise, if you used this system with us last year, you would just login and start a new registration for this current school year.

If you used this program last year with us, you will also notice a few changes this year, such as the amount of documents required to download and re-upload. **There's only one**; The sports evaluation and examination!

#### NOTE:

If your doctor has a **SPORTS PHYSICAL** form that differs from the AIA form that we provide, you are free to use it instead, <u>as long as it states that your athlete is cleared for participation</u>.

For all of the other documents, you will use a digital signature. Also, you will notice that there are NO actual sports to choose from. Since this is only a place to store and manage athletic packets, there are no sports to actually select. You will only complete one "packet" will be required per year and will remain valid for the entire school year. Our hope is that these changes will alleviate some of the monotony of so many forms that parents are required to fill out every school year, and also allow us to maintain more accurate and complete records.


- Please enroll your student by midnight the day before you need them to attend before or after school study hall at cs.cfsd16.org.
