WAITLIST POLICY

If a class you are wanting to register for fills up, please make sure you click on the yellow button on the class, to be added to the wait list. This will ensure you are contacted if a spot becomes available.

WALKING HOME

If you would like your student to walk home from our extended day activities, please complete" Walking Home Permission Slip" available from your CS Site Lead, and return it to him/her to keep on file for the current school year. If we do not have a signed permission slip, your student will not be permitted to walk home from our activities.

CELL PHONES & OTHER COMMUNICATION DEVICES

CLASS CANCELLATION

Classes are subject to cancellation due to low enrollment. If this happens, you will be contacted by either phone or email prior to the start of the class and awarded a full refund or the option to switch to another class.

ATTENDANCE

Attendance is taken for all extended day activities, and absences must be emailed by the parents to the After School Coordinator by 2:00pm the day of the class. If students are not in their classes by 3:30pm, an email will go home to parents.

LATE PICK-UP FEE

A \$3 per minute fee will be charged for those students who remain on campus after 4:30pm. Please be on time for pick-up.

REFUND POLICY

When dropping out of an activity after the first class, you will receive a refund of 50%. NO REFUNDS will be given after the second day of class. There will be a \$10 change fee for any class changes after the start of the class. NO REFUNDS will be given if we remove your student from class. If you are interested in registering for athletics this year, you need to complete an athletic packet. This is done through the AKTIVATE website at <u>registermyathlete.com</u>. Your athlete will need to be cleared by a doctor every year and you'll download the form for this sports physical that's required when you're completing the process here. NOTE: Just like our registration program, if you already have an account, you just need to log in and complete a new registration for this school year.

My biggest tip... watch for the quarterly registration dates on each quarter's brochure and prepare to log in to your account promptly at 8:30am on those dates. These classes (especially athletics) fill up super fast!! You'll want to be sure to secure your spot early.

ENROLLMENT INFO FOR THE 2024/2025 SCHOOL YEAR

OUR PROGRAMS:

Community Schools offers:

- Study Hall Each day after school Monday Friday, 2:45 4:15pm and Wednesday mornings from 7:30 9:00am.
- Enrichment Classes Each quarter after school (and before school on Late Start Wed.) Art, Computer Coding and Game Design, Chess, Drama, Crafting, Yearbook, Cooking and more!
- Athletics We offer a wide variety of sports activities for our students, both Intramural (6th grade) and Interscholastic (7th & 8th grades) An athletic packet will need to be uploaded to the RegisterMyAthlete program as described below.

HOW TO ENROLL:

We post the brochures on ParentSquare a few days prior to each quarter's enrollment. If you prefer, we always post our brochure online at https://communityschools.cfsd16.org/home/school-programs/middle-school-programs so you can check the website a few days before enrollment begins!

SOME TIPS:

Our classes and athletic programs fill up <u>very</u> quickly - sometimes within a few minutes! We encourage you to, if you haven't already, set up a Community Schools account ahead of time to make registration quick and easy at cs.cfsd16.org NOTE: If you already have an account, you will simply log in, and update your account by clicking on the NEW 2024/2025 Registration button and make sure your info is current or updated.

- All students who signed up for Athletics are required to have a current sports physical and
 a completed athletic packet in order to participate. This must be turned in before they can
 attend a practice or participate in any games. Go to the AKTIVATE program,
 www.registermyathlete.com, and create an account. Here, you will download, sign and
 upload the forms to us for safe keeping. We will keep it on file for the entire school year, so
 you only have to do this once per school year.
- Class enrollment is ONLY available ONLINE. If a class or sport is full, you can be added to the waitlist. You will be contacted if a spot becomes available to you.
- **STUDY HALL** is available for enrollment on a per day basis. You can choose which days your child needs to attend by selecting them on the calendar, and you can schedule as far in advance as you like.

<u>Important Enrollment Deadline:</u> You must enroll your child **by MIDNIGHT the night before attendance** to avoid late fees.

<u>Please Note:</u> If your child arrives at Study Hall and is not enrolled on the roster, they will be sent to the office to call home.

At that point, parents can either:

- Contact Community Schools to enroll for that day, 520-209-7562 and pay the additional
 \$15 late fee, or
- Pick up their child from the office.






